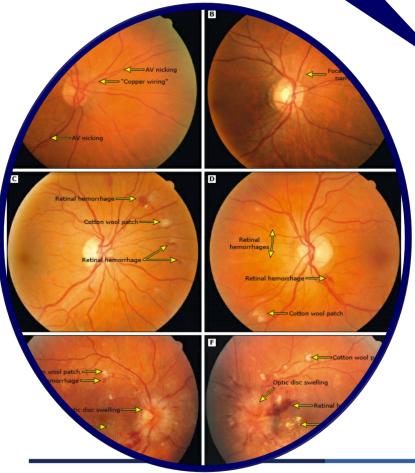


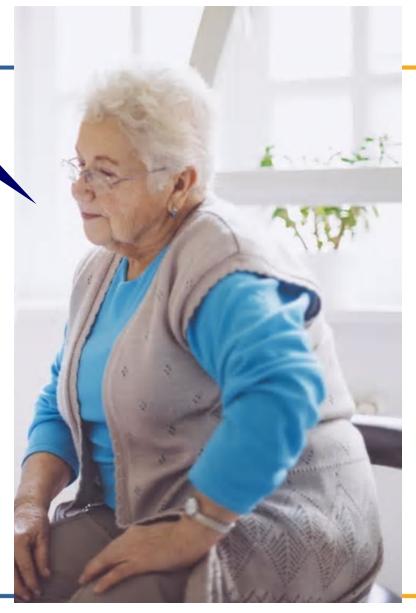




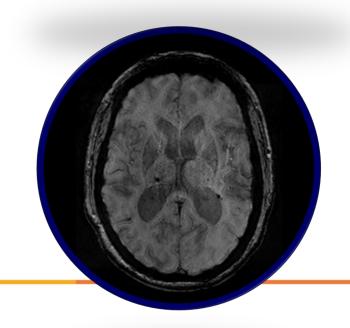

#### Meaningful patient interventions in the ED

- Adherence to dietary and lifestyle choices
- Adherence to chronic antihypertensive medications
- Daily blood pressure monitoring
- Follow up with PCP for further decision-making
