

CME/AOA Credit Claim Instructions

Below is the process for learners to claim credit:

- 1. A link to the evaluation and attestation forms will be emailed to all attendees after the last session on the last day of the CME activity **using the email address we have on file in the registration database.** *This link is also posted on the ACOEP designated conference website.*
- 2. Upon completion of the course evaluation form, you will be directed to the CME attestation form to confirm all the conference sessions and events you've attended.
- The CME attestation form closes approximately <u>90 days</u> after the CME activity. (January 14, 2022) Learners are encouraged to complete this process prior to the closing date. Learners who miss the credit claiming deadline must email <u>pferchland-bingham@acoep.org</u> and will experience significant delays in credit processing.
- All learners who complete both the <u>evaluation and attestation forms</u> prior to the designated closing date will receive their CME certificate via email*.
 *Certificates will be emailed the week of January 17, 2022.
- 5. ACOEP will report AOA 1-A credits for all learners who complete both the **evaluation and attestation forms** prior to the designated closing date.

Virtual Activities Note: It is the expectation that learners participate in the live activity in a timely fashion and are encouraged to claim CME credits by the designated closing date set by ACOEP.

ACOEP also provides a breakdown of the subspecialty credit(s) (trauma, infectious disease, pediatrics etc.) and the final totals are included on the CME certificates.
