At the American College of Osteopathic Emergency Physicians Resident and Student Organization (ACOEP-RSO), we are deeply committed to supporting and investing in the future of our specialty through informed and inclusive mentorship. For many medical students, access to Emergency Medicine (EM)-focused mentorship opportunities is limited or unavailable close to home. Those connections yielded interview invitations and even personal recommendations on our behalf.
